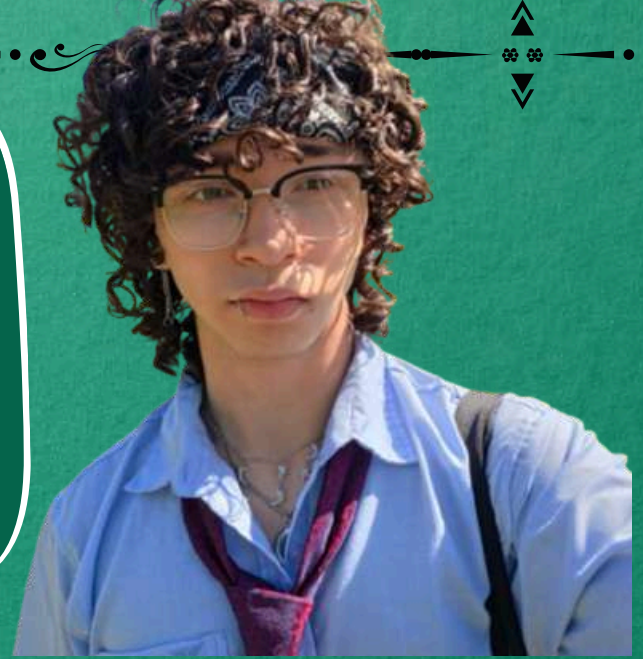

Hello Key Club International! My name is Marco Osorio, and I'm a two-term Lieutenant Governor from New Jersey Division 15. Through leading my division, securing a YOF Grant for my home club, and logging 500+ hours of service, one thing has become impossible to ignore: we keep calling ourselves an international organization, but most of us have never once connected with a member outside our own district. This isn't a criticism, it's an opportunity.

I'm running for International Vice President because the most untapped resource in all of Key Club isn't a program or a policy, it's each other. Through CATS (Connect All Through Service), I want to build the bridges that make INTERNATIONAL actually mean something: real CROSS-DISTRICT collaboration, real RECOGNITION for general members on a global stage, and a culture where the members who go above and beyond don't just get a pat on the back from their home club, but are CELEBRATED by all of Key Club International. We already have everything we need. Let's start acting like it.



So remember, vote CATS, vote Marco! (no, not polo)

Connect

Imagine the service and impact we could have if entire districts actually collaborated, not just waved at each other from across the internet, but truly worked together toward a shared goal.

ALL

Amplify every member's voice on the international stage, because at the end of the day, the general member is the most important member, and right now, too many of them are invisible beyond their own club.

Through

Using service as the medium to transform how Key Club defines "international"; when we serve together across borders, collaboration stops being a talking point and starts being real.

Service

Strengthen our global impact one shared project at a time, because service is the one language every Key Clubber already speaks, we just need to start using it together.

Q1: Connect

- Launch the CATS cross-district collaboration initiative and formally introduce it
- Create a structured incentive program: recognition at ICON, shoutouts on KCI platforms, and formal acknowledgment from the IBoard
- Actively drive district participation in the Global Engagement Rally
- Use the GER as the first major touchpoint for cross-district relationship building

Q2: All

- Leverage connections made at the GER to launch the first round of cross-district collaborative service projects
- Propose and establish a new international-scale recognition award specifically for general members who go above and beyond
- Open nominations to all districts globally and formalize the selection criteria with the IBoard
- Reward district governors and trustees who facilitate cross-district service projects

Q3: Through

- Mid-year check-in with district governors and trustees on collaboration incentive progress
- Launch a recurring KCI social media series spotlighting general members worldwide nominated by their districts
- Begin planning and shaping the agenda for the next GER push for more cross-district breakout sessions and content rooted in the CATS framework

Q4 Service

- Evaluate all initiatives using member feedback and engagement data
- Publish a full international engagement report with transparency on what worked and what didn't
- Present a sustainability roadmap to the incoming board so none of this dies when the term ends
