Why present?

When you present, you have the opportunity to:

- Share your story and message, and work with a diverse audience of tomorrow's leaders from all over the world;
- Build your professional portfolio while equipping Key Club members with the tools to impact their communities positively; and
- Receive free registration to the entire day of learning and networking if you are not a Key Club member.

What kind of workshops are featured at international convention?

Convention workshop objectives are to:

- Raise awareness about service opportunities and potential partnerships;
- Build members' leadership capacity and character potential;
- Provide members with the research and tools to design both
 - meaningful, measurable and impactful service projects and
 - efficient and effective fundraisers; and
- Allow members to learn from one another, build relationships and have fun.

To whom will I be presenting?

Breakout session presenters should expect a diverse group of participants representing one or more of the following groups:

- Youth, who comprise our primary audience and are members at-large;
- Graduate members and officers at the club, district and international levels; and
- Adults who are district administrators, Kiwanis sponsors, or faculty advisors.

How are selections made?

Key Club staff consider the following items when selecting workshops and presenters:

- Appealing and relevant title and content
- Interactive and engaging format
- Appropriate for a mixed audience or for the specified audience
- Evidence supporting presenter qualifications
- Reflection of the overall workshop objectives in the proposed session content and structure
- Completion of application

Do I have to attend the entire convention if I am presenting?

Key Club members must attend the convention in full to be considered for selection.
