- Identify members strengths and interests
- Plan for officer elections—orientation meeting, elections, training, establish committees
- Plan for chartering celebration—invite school leaders, sponsoring Kiwanis club, parents, Key Club LTG—install officers
- Prepare club calendar—check school and district Key Club calendars—schedule sponsoring Kiwanis club, Key Club LTG to attend meeting—attend Kiwanis club meeting
- Establish club presence in school—website and social media, meet with principal and other leaders, PTA and PTO, become the "go to" group for help in the school
- Invite leaders of other school clubs to Key Club meeting and officers attend other club meetings
- Conduct school and community needs assessment—poll students, teachers, staff, parents, school board, community non-profits
- Prepare list of potential service projects
- Schedule service projects in conjunction with Kiwanis club and other clubs in school
