General Awards + App. Process:



- **Major Emphasis Award:** Brand enhancing: The project should be designed to elevate the Kiwanis brand in the local community. May include newspaper clippings, substantiating photographs or other pertinent information.
- **Single Service Award:** Points allocated to the following categories: service need, project plan, project implementation, final results, public awareness, and member participation.

General Awards + App. Process:



- **Distinguished Club Award:** Check the requirements when beginning your service here to ensure you meet all deadlines, and number restrictions.
- **NEW: Significant Service Award.** Brand enhancing: The project should be designed to elevate the Kiwanis brand in the local community.

Tips + tricks when applying: Take a look at requirements at the beginning of your term to ensure that you meet the criteria and can be reciprocated.
