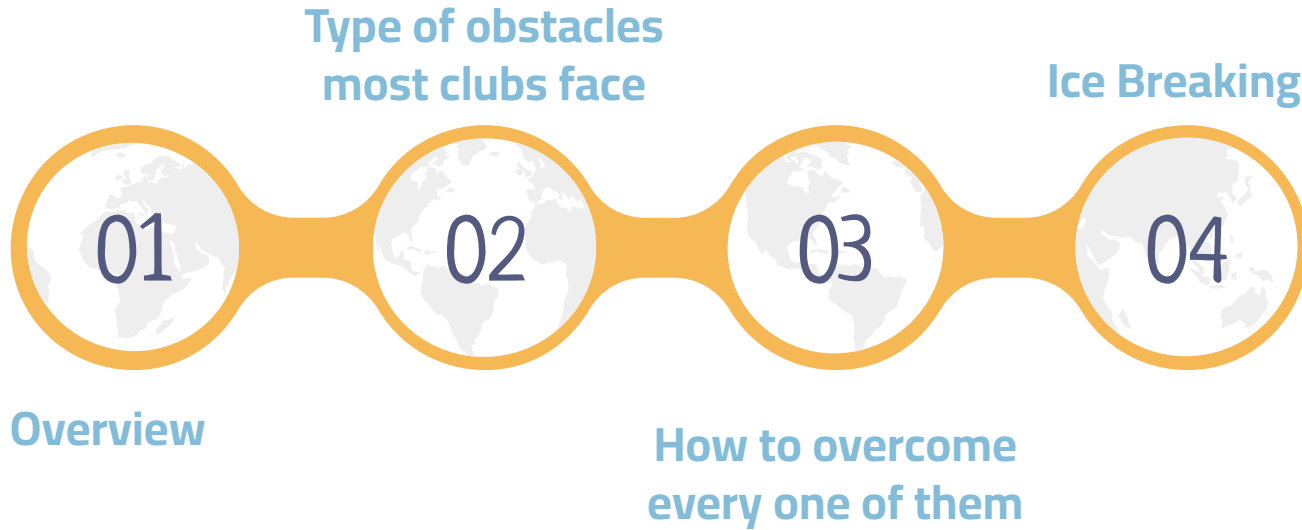
- Key Club Gabes Coast is the first key club in North africa and the middle east.

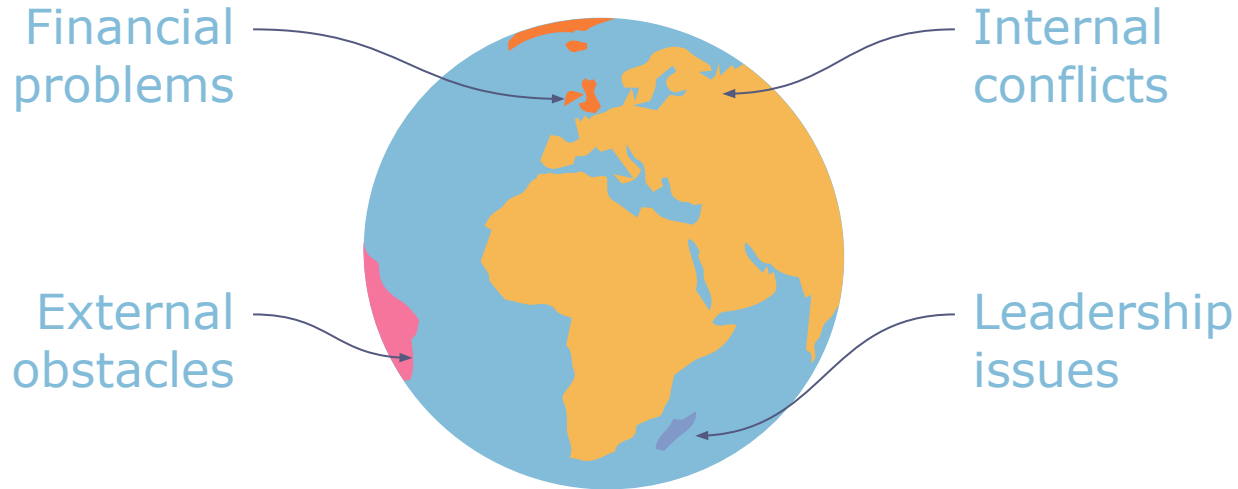

Financial Problems



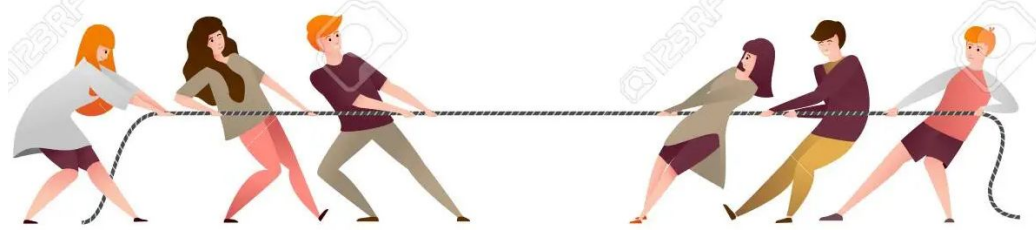
Money management is an important skill to develop, a way to start developing it is by:

Internal conflicts



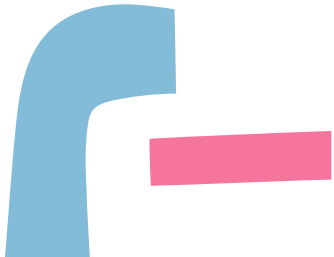
In order to avoid internal conflicts there are some thing :
